# **Key Vocabulary**

#### Remembrance

remember members of their armed forces who have died in the line of duty.

#### **Rationing**

Controlling the supply of food, clothes, petrol etc.

### **Occupied**

Taken over by enemy forces

# **Propaganda**

Any genre of media which is used to influence a persons attitude against a topic or theme

## Liberate

To free from an enemy's control

#### Camaraderie

mutual trust and friendship among people who spend a lot of time together.

#### Trench foot

Wearing poorly fitting boots, living in freezing mud and water sometimes led to trench foot.

#### **Blackout**

Wartime ban on lights at night

#### **Evacuee**

Somebody moved from danger to a safer place

#### Air-raid

An attack by planes dropping bombs

#### Holocaust

Mass murder of Jews and other people by the Nazis

#### **Blitz**

Short for 'blitzkrieg' meaning lightning war


