Physical Abuse



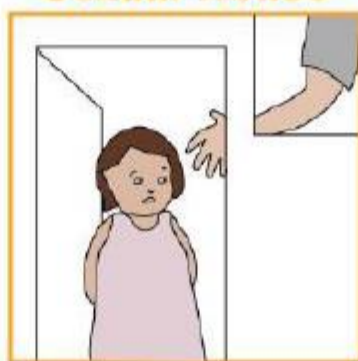
Harm to Your Body that Makes You Feel Pain
